Served on the CFRI Board of Directors. Writer and editor of the CFRI News, she also worked on staff in outreach. She continues to serve as a parent mentor and on the CFRI Conference committee. Kathleen is an active advocate for the CF community.
- Richard Moss, M.D.  
Served on the faculty of Stanford and Professor of Pediatrics. Dr. Moss has directed the pediatric pulmonary division and the Cystic Fibrosis Center at Stanford since 1991. He has co-authored over 130 scientific papers and made numerous presentations at regional, national and international medical meetings.
