

PHARMACEUTICAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

<u>AbbVie – CREON® CFCareForward</u>

Services offered:

- Co-pay assistance for CREON (pancrelipase)
- Multivitamin coverage
- Medication refill reminders
- Educational emails
- Support hotline

Eligibility:

- Individuals with Exocrine Pancreatic Insufficiency
- Patients with commercial prescription insurance coverage for CREON (Pancrelipase)
- People with federal, state, or government-funded insurance programs cannot access co-pay assistance or multivitamin coverage

<u>Genentech – Pulmozyme Co-pay Program</u>

Services offered:

 Co-pay assistance to help cover additional out-ofpocket costs for Pulmozyme, after you pay \$30 for each 30-day supply (Maximum \$10,000/year)

Eligibility:

- Are taking Pulmozyme for an FDA-approved use
- Have commercial (private or non-governmental) insurance
- Live and receive treatment in the US or US territories

 Are not receiving assistance through the Genentech Patient Foundation or any other charitable organization for the same expense

<u>Gilead – Cayston Access Program</u>

Services offered:

- Provides assistance for those who are uninsured or who have been denied coverage for Cayston
- Those who qualify may also qualify for assistance for additional or replacement parts for their Altera Nebulizer System

Eligibility:

- Meet income requirements
- No insurance coverage, or insured but denied coverage for Cayston

Nestlé Health Science – Live 2 Thrive

Services offered:

- Co-pay assistance on eligible Nestlé Health Services pancreatic enzyme prescriptions (12 fills of a 30-day supply or 4 fills of a 90-day supply)
- Free vitamins and supplements
- Loyalty rewards where participants can earn points and redeem them for a variety of nutritional and respiratory health products



Eligibility:

- Individuals with a valid prescription for an eligible Nestlé Health Science pancreatic enzyme
- Residents of Massachusetts, Michigan, Minnesota, or Rhode Island cannot receive rewards through the Live2Thrive program
- People with federal, state, or government-funded insurance programs are not eligible for the Live2Thrive program


<u>Vertex Pharmaceuticals – Guidance & Patient Support (GPS)</u>

Services offered:

- Co-pay Assistance Program (Maximum \$20,000/year)
- Understanding your insurance plan
- Plan medication refills
- Nutritional & physical activity guidance
- Educational resources

Eligibility:

- Individuals with a Vertex modulator therapy prescription
- Not available to individuals with government-funded insurance





Viatris - PODCARE+ (Tobi Podhaler)

Services offered:

- Insurance coverage reviews
- Therapy support calls as a periodic check-in
- Tobi Podhaler savings card for up to \$14,000/year

Eligibility:

- Tobi Podhaler savings card is not valid for uninsured patients or those who are enrolled in a federal or state healthcare program
- Individuals must have commercial insurance

<u>Viatris – Patient Assistance Program</u>

Services offered:

 Certain medications may be free to patients with a demonstrated financial need

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be fully uninsured, or if insured, have no prescription drug insurance
- The requested medication must be prescribed by a licensed U.S. healthcare professional for a FDA approved indication

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE PROGRAMS

<u> Bonnell Foundation – Medical Assistance Program</u>

Services offered:

 Financial assistance not covered by insurance or any other program to help cover various costs Examples include: Durable medical equipment, counseling services, medical care (up to \$500 twice per year), ambulatory services, and CF medications

Eligibility:

- Applicants must provide a letter confirming CF diagnosis
- · Provide related bill(s) requesting direct payment

<u>Boomer Esiason Foundation – Patient & Family</u> <u>Assistance Programs</u>

Services offered:

- IVF Grant
- Financial Hardship Assistance Fund

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a person with CF, and a US citizen or legal permanent resident
- Must demonstrate proof of financial hardship and consequently cannot meet financial obligations
- Additional eligibility criteria vary depending on program and can be found on webiste

<u>Claire's Place Foundation – Hospital Stay Grant</u>

Services offered:

- One-time financial assistance for families who have someone with CF in the hospital
- · Examples: rent, utilities, and other monthly bills
- Grants range from \$500-\$3,500/one grant recipient



The Cystic Dreams Fund – General Financial Grants

Services offered:

- Provides general financial assistance to individuals and families struggling with the costs associated with cystic fibrosis
- Assistance grants are usually issued through the form of direct payments to outstanding bills

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be the parent or legal guardian of a minor child with CF or be an adult with CF
- Verification of CF status
- Verification of bill for which you are requesting financial assistance (mortgage, rent, car payments, or fertility treatment bills are not accepted)

<u>Cystic Fibrosis Family Connection – Emergency</u> <u>Fund</u>

Services offered:

 Financial assistance for expenses temporarily beyond a family's means, such as lodging for a transplant visit or baby formula

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be a person with CF with demonstrated financial need
- Applicants are referred via CF clinic social worker, case manager, or other member of care team

<u>Healthwell Foundation – Cystic Fibrosis Treatment</u> Fund

Services offered:

- Cost-share and premium cost assistance for indicated prescription drugs and biologics used by people with CF
- Financial assistance with vitamins and supplements **Eligibility**:
 - Applicants must be actively receiving treatment for CF in the US
 - Have insurance that covers required medications
 - Income falls within 500% of the Federal Poverty Level

<u> Jeffery's House – Financial Assistance Grants</u>

- <u>Transplant housing grant</u>
 - Applicants must be diagnosed with a condition that requires organ transplantation and travel to a Bay Area Hospital and be in need of lodging for the mandated 3-month post-transplant stay
- Living essentials allowance grant
 - Applicants must be diagnosed with a condition that requires organ transplantation and travel to a Bay Area Hospital

<u>Living Breath Foundation – Financial Assistance</u> <u>Program</u>

Services offered:

 Broad financial assistance to individuals or families with CF who are facing financial hardship

Eligibility:

- Applicants must have CF and be US citizens who reside in California or Arizona
- Must provide the first two pages of their tax return and current payroll stub
- Be able to provide a letter from your CF doctor confirming diagnosis of disease

<u>BreatheStrong CF – Susan C. Burroughs Critical</u> Needs Initiative

Services offered:

- Provides financial assistance in the form of grocery and/or fuel gift cards
- Monthly support is available up to \$1,000 per patient per calendar year

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be an active client of a CF Care Center located in Georgia or be a Georgia resident working with the CF Foundation COMPASS Program
- Be referred by your social worker, case manager, or another member of the healthcare team

Eligibility will vary depending on state guidelines.

<u>Vivian Lee Foundation – Family Assistance Program</u>

Services offered:

- · Childcare for sibling during clinic visits
- · Loss of income for parents to attend clinic visits
- Loss of income for hospitalization (rent, utilities, etc.)
- Additional medical expenses after insurance
- · Gas for to and from clinic visit

Eligibility

 Eligibility criteria will vary based on type of assistance, and amount of assistance will vary per family and per applicat per family and per applicationion

 Families must have verified CF status and may apply for assistance a maximum of six times per year



SCHOLARSHIPS

AbbVie- CF Scholarship Program

Services offered:

 An annual offering of \$3,000 to 40 scholars, with one undergraduate and one graduate student selected to receive an additional \$22,000 each

Eligibility:

- Applicants must be people with CF applying for an undergraduate or graduate program in the upcoming academic year

- Applicants can be full-time or part-time students

INSURANCE, BILLING & LEGAL ASSISTANCE

 Copay assistance for out-of-pocket costs for prescribed FDA-approved treatments

Eligibility:

- US citizen or permanent resident who has been diagnosed with CF
- Prescribed an FDA-approved treatment for CF
- Have prescription coverage for the prescribed treatment and meet financial eligibility criteria
